on the part of the IOC that its main role at the Games is not one of a gold prospector and hence acknowledgement of the fact that television rights should take into account the "Olympic servitudes" accepted by its television partners.

At this point we are, it would seem, very far from "Olympic temples"! Not at all. While dissociating myself from a particular style of action, I have simply attempted to demonstrate that there is a possible alternative which will maintain and, where necessary, restore our credibility, the public confidence which is indispensable to us if we are to perform our task successfully, a task, which is proving more urgent but also more fascinating every day for those modern alchemists who are constantly seeking to achieve in every domain the right Olympic mix.
