

A FORMER NOC PRESIDENT ELECTED HEAD OF STATE IN POLAND

Aleksander Kwasniewski, elected President of the Polish Republic on 19 November 1995, was NOC president from 1988 to 1991 and head of the Polish delegation at the Games of the XXIV Olympiad in Seoul, in 1988. Born in Bialogard on 15 November 1954, the new head of state occupied several important positions within his country's youth movement, and served as minister and subsequently

as president of the Committee for Youth and Physical Culture from 1985 to 1990.
