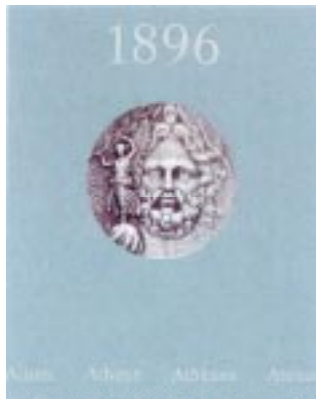

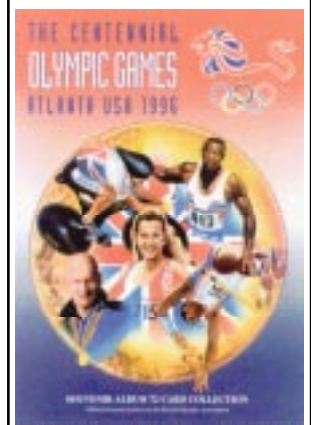
With a preface by the IOC President, this book is a col-

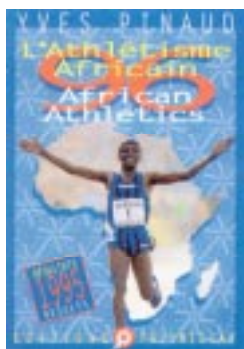

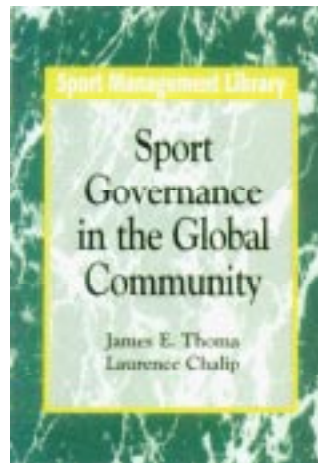

With a preface by IAAF president Primo Nebiolo, and Lamine Diack, president of the African Amateur Athletics Confederation, this work also lists the principal records set by these athletes at national, international and world championships.



## Sport Governance in the Global Community
