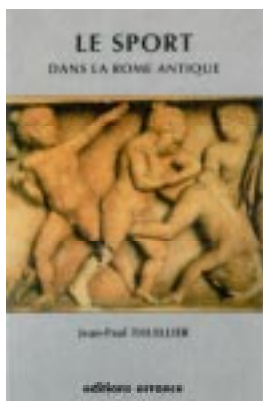

## Le sport dans la Rome antique

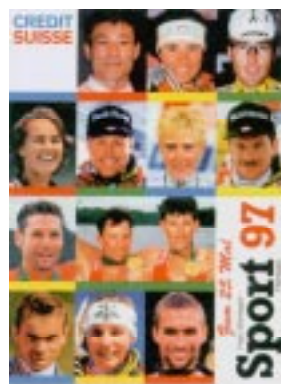
("Sport in Ancient Rome") by Jean-Paul Thuillier, Editions Errance, 7 rue Jean-du-Bellay, 75004 Paris (FRA). 1996. 190 pages in French. Price: FF 195. The author, a professor at the Ecole Normale Supérieure, describes the importance of sport as a key to understanding Roman civilization from a political and sociological point of view, from its origins until late Antiquity.



## Sport '97

This is the 25th edition of the official handbook of Swiss sport, providing a complete account of the 1996 year in sport as well as statistics and a calendar of events for 1997. It covers over 80 sports disciplines and is richly illustrated with photographs.



## Les mots du sport - La tête dans le guidon

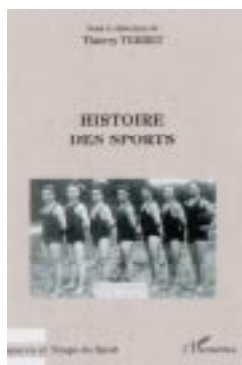

This sports dictionary compiled by a young journalist contains over 2,500 words and phrases from around 50 sports. Readers are sure to enjoy the colourful, idiomatic expressions - some with double meanings - which the author has picked up in the course of his work.



## Histoire des sports

("History of sports"), compiled by Thierry Terret, Editions L'Harmattan, 5-7 rue de l'Ecole Polytechnique, 75005 Paris (FRA). 1996. 250 pages in French. Price: FF 150.

Drawing on a number of examples from cycling, gymnastics, judo, swimming, tennis, skiing, rugby, sailing and mountaineering, the eleven contributing authors describe and analyse the relative autonomy of the history of different sports from a multidisciplinary (sociological, anthropological, historical, etc.) perspective.



## Sport et Littérature

("Sport and literature"), a publication of the literary journal Europe, 64 boulevard Auguste-Blanqui, 75013 Paris (FRA). June-July 1996. Price: FF 95. In this special edition readers will discover some remarkable and previously unpublished works of poetry and prose, including essays, on various aspects of sport in the literary world. The unusual and enlightening contributions include "From poem to sport and from sport to poem", a literary interpretation of surfing, and references to sport and politics in the works of Joyce.



## Les Conquérants de l'Olympe - Naissance du sport moderne

In this very beautiful album, the author has collected many stories about the colourful characters who have peopled the history of sport. Superb illustrations reproduced from popular period publications, such as *Le Petit Parisien*, *Le*

*Petit Journal* and *L'illustration*, make this a book to treasure.
