In November, Vilnius hosted a conference on cooperation between governmental and non-governmental sports organizations, which was organized jointly by the Council of Europe and the

Lithuanian parliament and government. At the end of the discussions a resolution was signed by Mikko Elo, chairman of the youth and sport sub-committee of the Council of Europe's culture and instruction committee, and by Arvydas Vidziunas, vice presi-

dent of the Lithuanian parliament. The main objectives of the resolution were to create within the parliament a commission for youth and sport, to change the existing laws on tax benefits for sports organizations, and to ratify the European Convention on Fair Play.
