

## **2nd Islamic Countries' Women's Games**

The second edition of the Islamic Countries' Women's Games took place in Teheran (Iran) from 13 to 20 December 1997. Organized by the Islamic Countries' Women's Sports Solidarity Council (ICWSSC) under the presiden-

cy of Faezeh Hashemi, who is also vice president of the Iranian NOC, the Games brought together Muslim sportswomen from 21 countries and featured 13 sports on their programme. The competition venues were

spread over the country in several cities. An IOC delegation, led by Anita DeFrantz, IOC vice president, was present in Teheran and spoke with Mostafa Hashemi Taba, president of the NOC and vice president of the Islamic Republic of Iran, on the development of women's sport and of sport in general in his country.
