

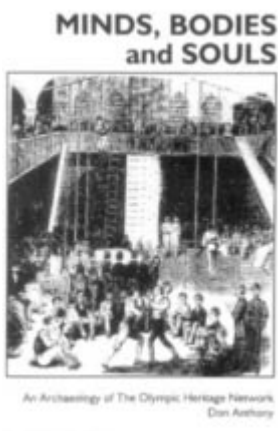

Monaco - Naissance d'une vocation sportive 1862 - 1939

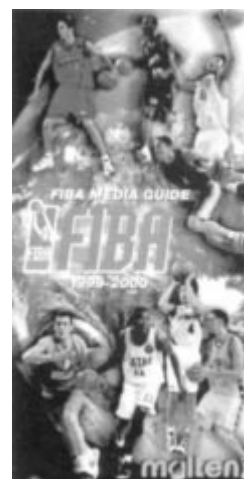

With a preface by IOC member Prince Albert of Monaco, this first volume retraces the sporting history of the Principality of Monaco from 1862 to 1939. Written at the instigation of the late Georges Bertellotti, who 'wanted to discover the origins of

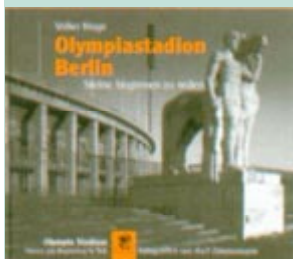
Monaco's sporting vocation', this lavishly-illustrated reference work covers all the sports which make Monaco one of the most renowned names in the sports world today.
