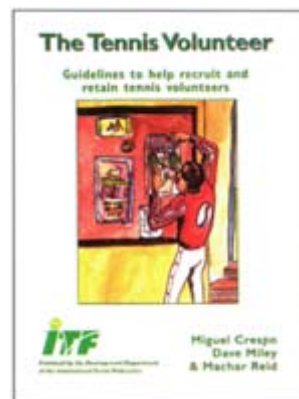
## The Tennis Volunteers

In the framework of the International Year of Volunteers proclaimed by the General Assembly of the United Nations, the International Tennis Federation (ITF) has formally recognised the important role that volunteerism plays in its sport. In 2001, the ITF Development Department has produced the *Tennis Volunteer* book which has been sent to all ITF mem-

ber countries. For the ITF president, Francesco Ricci Bitti, *"tennis is blessed with outstanding volunteers at every level of the game. At tournament level, in administrative roles at national and regional associations, in local leagues and clubs, volunteers are the foundation upon which tennis is built"*. This document is the first of its kind to inform and to provide

national and regional tennis associations with some important guidelines on how to better attract, train, recognise and retain volunteers, and also on how to best help volunteers perform more effectively and enjoy their involvement in tennis. Among the different chapters, you will find 'what is a volunteer', 'why people volunteer?', 'working with volunteers'

'motivating and keeping volunteers', and 'rights and duties of volunteers'.

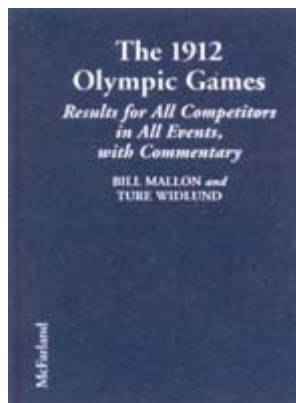


## The 1912 Olympic Games - Results for all competitors in all events, with commentary

by Bill Mallon and Ture Widlund, published by McFarland & Company, Inc., Publishers, Box 611, Jefferson, North Carolina 28640 (United States). 2002. 592 pages in English. Price : US\$ 59,50.

This work is the sixth in a series of seven giving complete summaries of the earliest Olympic Games. Mallon and Widlund, also the coauthors of *The 1896 Olympic Games* (published in 1997) provide extensive information on the venues, dates, com-

petitors and nations of the Games of the V Olympiad in Stockholm in 1912. Results for all the 15 sports (102 events) and for the five art competitions are also provided.

by the Brazilian Olympic Committee, Rua da Assembléia, 10 Salas 3207-3213, Rio de Janeiro 20119-900 (Brazil). 2001. 140 pages in Portuguese and English. With a preface by the Sports and Tourism Minister, Carlos Melles, and the NOC president and IOC member, Carlos Arthur Nuzman, this

work is devoted to Brazil's participation in the Games of the XXVII Olympiad in Sydney in 2000. Numerous pictures show the high points of these 15 Olympic days during which Brazilian athletes were amongst the medal winners, and the book also lists all their results sport by sport.
