1913-1917 : 5 times norwegian champion ice-hockey (bandy).

1919-1924 : 6 times norwegian champion ice-hockey (bandy).

1915-1918 : 5 times international player for Norway in football.

1913-1924 : numerous prices ski jumping and-running, whereof a great number first prices.

1914-1948 : more than one hundred prices yachting, mostly in the 8-meter and 6-meter classes.

1936 : silver medal olympic yachting Kiel in the 8-meter class.

1915-1930 : represented Norway several times in international matches in ice-hockey and bandy.

1910-1930 : numerous prices in tennis, athletics and skating, whereof for instance 2nd price tennis double, norwegian championship 1920.

Mr. Ahmed E.-H. Jaffar, President of the Pakistan Olympic Association, Karachi, is a welknown Sportsman of Pakistan. Until the partition of India, he was a member of the Indian Parliament, and is now a Member of the Pakistan Parliament.

He is an all-round sportsman and led the Pakistan Contingent to the XIV World Olympiad held in London in 1948.

Mr. Jaffar is keenly interested in horse riding, and has been for a number of years a member of the Poona and Kirkee Hunt, and played Polo when he was attached to some of the Cavalry units in India, and went through his riding course with the Poona Horse, the Royal Deccan Horse, and later with the Bombay Governor's Bodyguards.

Mr. Jaffar is a member of several sporting Clubs in India and Pakistan, and Plays practically all games including Tennis, Squash, Golf, Cricket, Rowing, Sailing, Swimming, Polo, etc.
