

are chosen for Trophy honors. Lodged there, also, will be the awards won by the honored athletes.

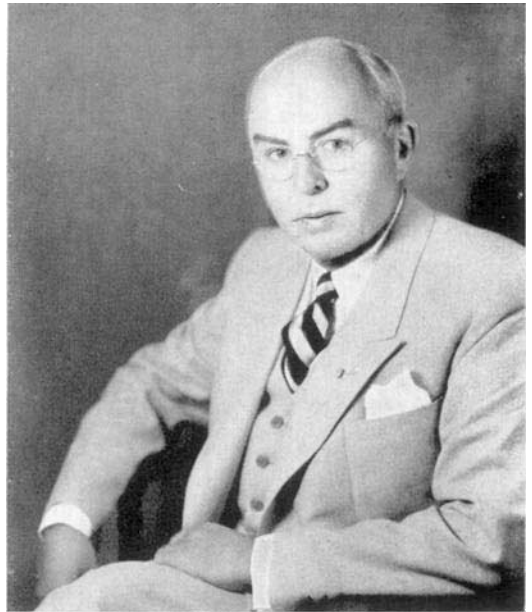
The Trophy Board will also make an effort to secure official emblems from each of the Nations and Kingdoms which the honored athletes represented when chosen for honors.

Their recommendations will be considered annually by the Trophy Board, the members of which will make final selections.
