

To the Olympic Stadium will furthermore be sold a small amount of special tickets of varying prices between 15-10 dollars.

How the sale will be arranged in the different countrys abroad has not yet been decided on. 50% of all admission tickets will be made available abroad.

When buying admission tickets, an Olympic visitor may reserve accommodation by purchasing the necessary lodging vouchers (one for each day). The Lodging Office does not guarantee accommodation for those Olympic visitors who are whitout a lodging voucher.

The different accommodation available, and prices:

1. *Private accommodation:*

I class single room: dollars 5,00 4,00, 3,50, 3,00.

I class double room: dollars 6,00, 5,00, 4,50, 4,00.

I class room with 3 beds: dollars 7,00, 6,00, 5,50, 5,00.

II class single room: dollars 3,00, 2,80, 2,50

II class double room: dollars 4,00, 3,70, 3,40.

II class room with 3 beds: dollars 5,00, 4,60, 4,30.

III class single room: dollars 2,00, 1,70.

III class double room: dollars 2,30, 2,00.

III class room with 3 beds: dollars 2,90, 2,60.

2. *Community housing.*

Bed (with blanket and sheets): dollar 1,50.

A bed without blanket and sheets (the visitor must provide the necessary bedclothes himself): dollar 1,00.

3. *Camping accommodation.*

A bed in a tent: dollar 0,60.

A camp site: dollar 0,30.

4. *Hotel accommodation.*

All the hotel rooms in Helsinki are reserved for foreign Olympic visitors. The prices will be fixed and announced later.

**L'Exposition d'Art à Helsinki en 1952**

Le Comité d'organisation des XV<sup>mes</sup> Jeux olympiques de 1952 a décidé à son assemblée du 18 juin dernier de mettre sur pied pendant les Jeux de 1952 une *Exposition d'Art*. The Organising Committee for the XVth. Olympic Games in 1952 has decided on its meeting of June 18th. that an *Art Exhibition* will be arranged during the 1952 Games since, in view of the lack of time, this Committee is not in a position to prepare an *Art Competition* following the actual Rules of the I. O. C., which have been changed at its Vienna Session in May last. Owing to the past circumstances the I. O. C. has agreed with the decision taken by the Finnish Committee.
