

## PUBLICATIONS ARISING FROM OLYMPIC SCIENTIFIC CONGRESS, OREGON, JULY, 1984

Two forthcoming major publications of interest to ASSH members will be the Proceedings of two sections of the Olympic Scientific Congress held in Eugene, Oregon immediately prior to the 1984 Olympics.

Selected papers from the Interdisciplinary Meetings of the Sport and Politics Section are being published in a book edited by Professor Gerald Redmond. The book, Sport and Politics is being published by Human Kinetics Publishers and is expected to be released within a few weeks.

The official Proceedings of the Disciplinary Meetings in Sport History is being published in West Germany and is being edited by Professor Norbert Meuller of the University of Mainz and Dr. Joachim Ruhl of the German University for Sports Sciences in Cologne.

The volume, entitled Sport History, will be published in English and will be approximately 400 pages in length. This volume contains abstracts and scientific papers of the 48 scholars who presented. It includes contributions by eminent sport historians and well-known experts in their special field of research, viz. R. A. Howell (Brisbane) : Australia's first female Olympians; J. S. Holt (College Park): American sportswomen's struggle for Olympic Gold: 1920-1980; H. Gillmeister (Bonn): Sport heroes and their qualities; J. A. Mangan (Glasgow): Tom Brown in tropical Africa: Idealism and realism; P. Miller (Berkeley): Origins of the athletic ideal in America; L. Olsen (San Diego): Hemingway's anti-hero; L. Diem (Cologne): The Olympic idea in Coubertin's philosophy; A. Renon (Leuven, Belgium): The 1920 Antwerp Olympic Games; M. Brichford (Urbana): Avery Brundage: The man and his collection; J. A. Lucas (University Park): The future of the International Olympic Movement; N. L. Struna (College Park): Sport in colonial America; R. C. Wilcox (Hempstead): Sport and the immigrant in 19th century America; R. J. Park (Berkeley): The 1915 San Francisco "World's Fair"; B. Stoddart (Canberra): Politics and propaganda in soccer: England vs. Germany, 1935; M. L. Howell (Brisbane): Sport in the colony of Queensland, 1859-1889.
