

POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP IN SPORTS HISTORY AT UNIVERSITY OF QUEENSLAND

Dr. David Brown from The University of Alberta, Edmonton, Canada has been awarded a Post-Doctoral Fellowship to undertake research in Sport History in the Department of Human Movement Studies at the University of Queensland.

David has a B.Ed. from Loughborough, M.Sc. from Dalhousie, Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada, and Ph.D. from University of Alberta. His dissertation title was "Athleticism in Selected Canadian Private Schools for Boys to 1918" (1984). His research interests focus on sport in Victorian and Edwardian society with particular reference to Canada and now Australia. Specific topics of investigation include muscular Christianity, athleticism and the association of sport with broader social issues such as social Darwinism, militarism and health concerns.

David took up residency in Brisbane in May, 1986.
