### **ASSH DISSERTATION PRIZE**

The 1990 Prize has been awarded to Veronica Raszeja Wood for her thesis 'The Rise of Women's Competitive Swimming in Sydney to 1912', University of New South Wales.

Veronica will receive \$100 from the Society and a one year subscription to ASSH. Her thesis is also being considered for publication in the ASSH Studies in Sports History series.

### **ASSH STUDENT ESSAY PRIZE**

The judges considered that no entry for the 1990 prize was of sufficient merit to justify an award.

## **ASSH STUDENT ESSAY AND DISSERTATION PRIZES**

ASSH awards two prizes annually for quality work by tertiary or secondary students in the general field of sports culture. Appropriate areas of focus are: sport and economics, sport in history, law, Literature, philosophy, politics, social psychology and sociology. Sports culture and tradition should be seen as being broad, not confined.

**The ASSH Dissertation Prize** will be awarded to an Honours thesis written in 1991 or 1992. One (returnable) copy should be submitted. The prize is \$100 and a one year subscription to ASSH. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the judging panel. The winning dissertations may be published as an ASSH Study in Sports History.

**The ASSH Essay Prize** will be awarded to an essay written in 1991 or 1992. Two copies should be submitted. The prize is \$100 and a one year subscription to ASSH. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the judging panel. The winning essay will be published in the ASSH *Bulletin*.
