"13" Reasons Why the Giants Lost

In the final game, on October 26th (2 x 13),

There were 13 Gothamites in action, and

In this same game the Athletics made 13 runs,

13 hits, and

13 assists.

There were 13 Athletics engaged in the series.

In the six games the Giants made 13 runs and

Thirty-nine (3 x 13) safe and sacrifice hits.

Mathewson retired 13 men on strikes.

The Giants batted .175 (1+7+5=13).

The New York Club's share of the gate receipts was \$90,108.72, being an even multiple of 13 (\$6,931.44X13)
