

### THE ONTARIO WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP

The Ontario Women's Golf Championship was held this year at the Brantford Golf and Country Club, and was crowned with very gratifying success. The annual meeting has usually been played in the larger golf centers of Ontario, but this year the governing body decided to stage the tournament at one of the smaller cities in order to encourage the members of such clubs to enter and thus promote a more general interest in the game throughout Canada's leading Province.

This year's tournament resulted in Miss Ada Mackenzie of the Mississauga Club, Toronto, for the second time securing the laurels.
