There will be two one-day events: September 3rd at the Greenwich Country Club, and September 8th at the Sleepy Hollow Country Club. The Association Championship Tournament will be played at the Mt. Kisco Golf Club, September 14th to 18th, inclusive. Also a two-day medal and match play event, October 1st and 2nd, at the Westchester-Biltmore-Country Club.
