

### **Mass. G. A. Meeting**

The Massachusetts Golf Association will hold its annual meeting and election in October, following the custom of the last two years, and one of the peculiar features in connection therewith is that the man who has served the last two years as president, namely, William F. Garcelon, will then be elected secretary of the Association, and the incumbent secretary, Raynor M. Gardiner, will be transferred to the office of president. This arrangement is at the request of Mr. Garcelon himself, who did not wish to serve again as president, but who was willing to continue as an officer in order that he may complete some of the plans which have been worked out under his administration.
