

Winter Golf at Miami

Miami is planning for some real golf during the coming season. Reports from the Coast indicate that some of the leading players who have not before participated in events in Florida, or Miami, on account of the conflict of dates, have announced that they will be present at Miami. Of course, some of the finer players are spending the winter in Florida, among them. Johnny Farrell, who, by the way, holds the record of the lowest average of the first ten professionals in America. Farrell has played 76 rounds in which he took a total of 5,555 strokes, giving him an average of about 73.1 for the year. Walter Hagen was second, having played 40 rounds with a total of 2,952 strokes, giving him an average of about 73.8. Tommy Armour, who played 86 rounds with a total of 6,391 strokes, had an average of around 74.20. The first Open tournaments at Miami will be at Miami Beach, January 2-3 and January 7-8. Johnny Farrell, Gene Sarazen, Willie Klein, Jock Hutchison and others will play in these tournaments. Harry Cooper, Al. Espinosa and others have indicated that they will play at the big Miami tournament in March. The Miami section of Florida is about to take up the game in a much broader way than heretofore, and results will be interesting.
