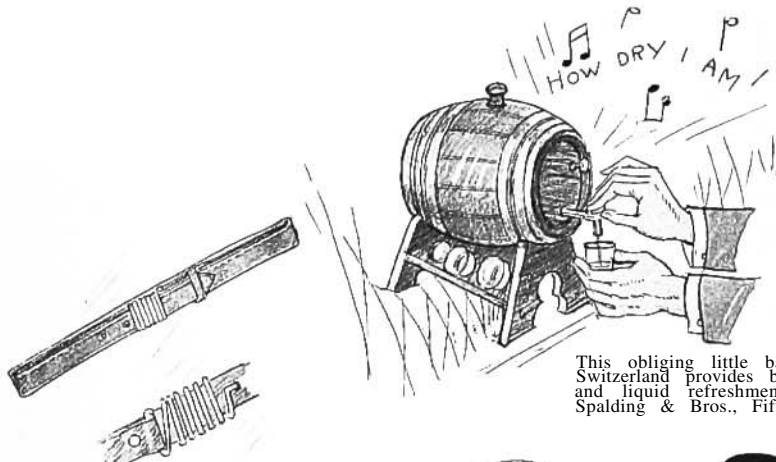
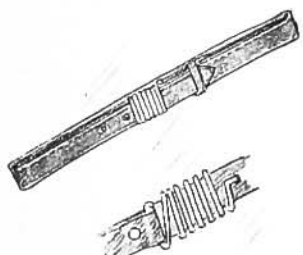


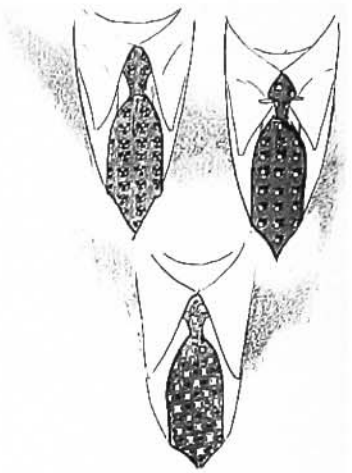

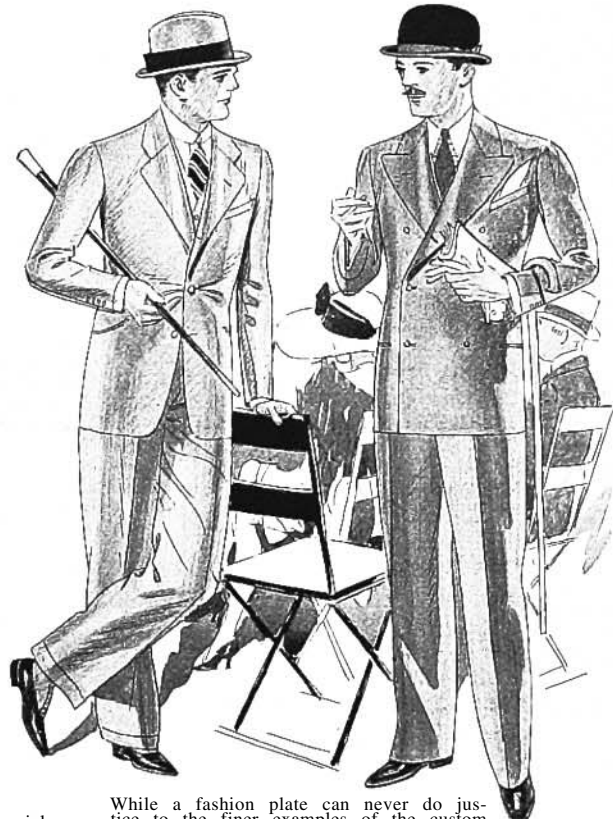
This obliging little barrel from Switzerland provides both music and liquid refreshment. A. G. Spalding & Bros., Fifth Avenue

Shoe No. 2—a sturdy white calfskin shoe trimmed with black calf and designed by Bobbie Cruickshank. Hanan & Son

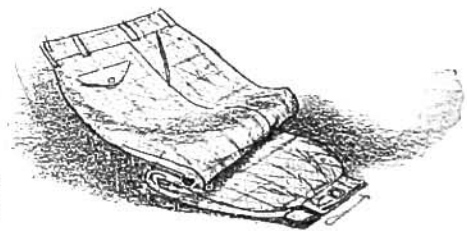
