

Ben Stevenson's Record

Ben Stevenson, the millionaire heating plant magnate, who five years ago at the age of 38 years took up golf and twenty-four months later shot a 69 over a championship course, wound up an eventful year by winning the Builders' Association championship with a new course record of 34-36-70, three under par, at Cog-Hill. Stevenson is a member of a half dozen golf clubs, including Olympia Fields, Beverly and Southmoor. He holds the Beverly record of 34-37-71, together with John McKinlay, Jr.

Stevenson last March won the Dixie amateur title at Miami, while in September he was runner-up to Dr. A. F. Henning in the club championship at Olympia Fields. He originally took up golf as a means of recuperating his health.
