Report on the meeting between the IOC President, H. E. Mr. J. A. Samaranch, and the President and Secretary - General of the International Society of Olympic Historians (I.S.O.H.), Mr. Ian Buchanan and Dr. Bill Mallon, in the presence of Mr. Wolf Lyberg and Dr. Karel Wendl, of 15th July 1993 at the IOC headquarters in Vidy.

The representatives of the ISOH spoke about the activities of their organization. They proposed that Mr. Samaranch should be named an honorary life member of their organization. The President of the IOC thanked them but refused to accept.

He said that a meeting or seminar would be organized in Lausanne next year under the auspices of the IOC to which some of the most outstanding scholars researching on the history of sport and the Olympic Movement would be invited. It will be a two or three day meeting and its purpose will be to examine how the IOC and these scholars should cooperate in the future.


Mr. Buchanan said the ISOH would like to be involved in this seminar. President Samaranch said the IOC would welcome proposals for the agenda of this meeting.

The ISOH has already printed three issues of its journal "Citius, Altius, Fortius". About 150 people were being sent the journal at present.

President Samaranch stated that the IOC would support the ISOH financially by giving them US \$ 1000.00 (one thousand) for every issue of their journal from this date on. The ISOH should write a letter concerning this matter to the IOC President's attention every time a new issue would be about to be published.

The question of eventual scholarships for Olympic historians was raised. Mr. Samaranch said this matter should be examined at the above mentioned meeting.

Mr. Samaranch said that both Mr. Buchanan and Dr. Mallon would receive the three volumes of de Coubertin's selected texts as a gift. ("Coubertin - Textes choisis" in French).
