

ANNUAL DUES

Following a review of the Society's financial position by President Ian Buchanan and Treasurer David Wallechinsky the situation has now been fully studied by the Executive Committee. As a result of this study it has been decided that from 1, January 1998 the undermentioned rates for membership shall apply. This is the first increase in the membership subscription in the six-year history of the ISOH and your Committee would like to point out that, at the moment, the cost of producing and distributing the Journal is about twice that of the annual subscription. Clearly, this situation could not continue and it is only thanks to the monies received from the IOC that it has not proved necessary to increase the dues even further.

Members who have paid in advance will not be affected until their next payment falls due and, of course, Lifetime Members will not be affected in any way.


