

# MESSAGE FROM THE TREASURER AND THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

---

**D**uring the meeting of the Executive Committee of the ISOH in Lausanne, August 1998, it was decided to add the newly introduced currency the EURO into ISOH finance. This method of payment has now been worked out by the treasurer and secretary-general. ISOH members living in countries belonging to the European Community, whose governments have decided to use the Euro as its future currency (see list below), can from January 1st, 1999, pay their yearly dues in this currency.

The methods for payment of yearly subscriptions, for all ISOH members, are described below.

Some of our members must still pay the dues over 1998. Most of them already did, but quite a few apparently forgot to do it in time. Please check for yourself if you did pay over the previous year?

## *METHODS FOR PAYMENT OF MEMBERSHIP DUES*

(NOTE: ALL CHEQUES SHOULD ONLY BE MADE PAYABLE TO THE I.S.O.H.)

NOTE: Countries which have decided to use the EURO instead of their own national currency are: Belgium, Germany, Finland, France, Ireland, Italy, Luxemburg, Netherlands, Austria, Portugal and Spain. The EURO will definitely replace the national currencies on 1 January 2002. The new currency may be used in international currency-exchange from 1 January 1999.
