MACMILLAN-SABR BASEBALL RESEARCH AWARDS

The Macmillan SABR Baseball Research Awards honor individuals who have conducted research in baseball related topics and whose work has expanded and deepened our knowledge and understanding of the National Pastime, contributing in a unique way to the growth of baseball bibliography. Three cash awards of \$200 each, sponsored by the Macmillan Publishing Company, awarded annually. One of the winners last year was Melvin Adelman of Ohio State University, for *A Sporting Time: New York City and the Rise of Modern Athletics, 1820-1870* (University of Illinois Press).

Nominations on behalf of other individuals or self-nominations are acceptable for projects completed in 1987 or 1988. Applicants need not be members of SABR to be eligible. A nominating petition requires the candidate's address, telephone number, title of project, and synopsis of project. Applications must be received at the following address by January 31, 1989 to be eligible for the 1988 awards:
