Especially requested are articles that extend the range of biography, autobiography, hagiography, or oral and group history into other fields and disciplines such as cultural studies, medicine, or science and technology. Works regarding non-Anglo-American subjects are encouraged. Manuscripts should be 2,500 to 7,500 words. Two copies are required. The author's name should appear on the cover letter only. Decisions about publication should be received within three months.

The North American Society for Sport History will hold its 25th annual conference at Springfield College, Massachusetts, May 23-26, 1997. Anyone interested in organizing a session or presenting a paper should include the following information with their submissions: Name, telephone number, address, and email and fax if available. Four copies are required. Session proposals should include a discussion of the theme and a statement regarding the historical significance of the topic. Proposals should be 750 to 1,000 words. Abstracts of the papers to be addressed in the session should be 500 to 700 words. Abstracts of individual papers should include comments about the topic, the evidence used, and a statement of historical significance, and should be 500 to 1,000 words.
