1972-1973

The position of NASSH Secretary-Treasurer was created after the May, 1972 meeting of NASSH in Windsor, Canada when the Chairman of the NASSH Steering Committee, Marvin Eyler, appointed committee members. The tasks of the Secretary-Treasurer during this organizing year have included:

- 1) Opening a checking account at the Mid-State Bank and Trust, State College, Pa.,
- 2) Sending out an announcement of the NASSH organization, the May convention, and membership forms to about 400 prospective members in December, 1972,
- 3) Accepting pre-registration for the 1st annual convention of NASSH,
- 4) Editing the 1st NASSH Newsletter in April 1973, and sending it out to about 1100 members and prospective members,
- 5) Collecting a book display for the NASSH Convention,
- 6) Inquiring about the possible publication of a NASSH Journal,
- 7) Writing for information on postal bulk mailing,
- 8) Writing for information on non-profit organizations for tax purposes, and
- 9) Accepting membership from individuals and institutions.
