
Publications Committee Report

The work of the publications committee has been devoted solely to the publication of the *Journal of Sport History*. It was hoped that the first issue of the Journal would be in the hands of the membership by the time of the Convention.

The major steps in the publication of the Journal were the establishment of an editorial board; the signing of a working relationship with Radford College, Radford, Virginia; and the selection of a printer, Southern Printing, Blacksburg, Virginia.

Through the goodwill of Dr. Margaret Woodhouse, Chairwoman, Department of History, Radford College an agreement was reached with Radford College whereby the College agreed to house the Journal and provide all the technical services in the publication of the Journal. As a result of the agreement Dr. E. Johnson, Radford College agreed to become Technical Editor and take charge of the operations at Radford College.

Several bids were obtained for publishing the Journal and the contract was awarded to Southern Printing, Blacksburg, Virginia.
