
Membership Committee Report

The work of the Membership Committee for 1973-74 has focused primarily on securing lists of and contacting potential members and providing publicity information about the annual conference. To date, the following charges have been accomplished:

1. Compiled mailing lists which were utilized by Ronald A. Smith, Secretary-Treasurer, for sending necessary information developed in his office.
 - a. Complete list of State and Province Historical Societies.
 - b. List of Sports Editors for newspapers with circulation of more than 200,000.
 - c. Selected list of Sports Museums.
 - d. Editors of selected lists of sports periodicals.
2. Mailed announcements with information about the forthcoming annual conference to selected physical education journals in Canada and the United States and to some leading newspapers.

Thus far, we have made no contacts with anyone from Mexico, but this is a population which needs exploring. We would appreciate any help from other NASSH members who might provide us with some initial contacts.

Recommendations for future responsibilities of this committee:

1. Establish an operating code which details the responsibilities of the Membership Committee.
2. Establish a calendar outlining deadline dates for performing these responsibilities.
3. Develop an operating procedure for close communication and cooperation with the Secretary-Treasurer in order to coordinate the efforts of that office and this committee for responsibilities that may otherwise overlap.
