

International Meeting of HISPA

The International Association for the History of Physical Education and Sport (HISPA) will hold its Fourth International Seminar at Leuven University, Belgium from April 2-5, 1975. It will be organized by the Physical Education Department of the Catholic University of Leuven, headed by Prof. Dr. P. P. de Nayer. The central theme of the Seminar will be "The history, evolution, and diffusion of sports and games in different cultures. In addition to papers read there will be a session on the teaching of history of physical education and sport and another on the history of women's physical education and sport. Official languages will be English, French, German, and Dutch. Individuals interested in presenting papers should send an abstract to Dr. R. The complete text of the paper, ready to be xeroxed (2,500 words maximum), should be sent to the above address before January 31, 1975.
