

HISPA Meeting in Mainz, Germany

The International Association for the History of Physical Education and Sport (HISPA) will have its 5th international congress at the Johannes Gutenberg-Universität in Mainz, Germany from April 11-15, 1976. The basic themes of the congress will be the "History and Structures of Sport at the Universities." There will also be open papers on the history of the Olympic games and sessions of the International Working Groups: Women's Physical Education; The Teaching of Sport History; Sport and Politics; and Comparative Physical Education. The official languages will be German, English, and French. Titles of presentations were to be received at the University in December with completed manuscript by January 15, 1976.
