

Nominating Committee Report

The 1976-77 Nominating Committee prepared slates for 2 elections by mail for the newly-authorized Publications Board, which President Lewis requested be elected as quickly as possible; and for the regular bi-annual election according to procedures established by Article X, Section 2, of the NASSH Constitution.

Ten nominees were proposed for the 5 places on the Publications Board. The names of the 7 who accepted were submitted to the Secretary-Treasurer on September 30, 1976. The final vote was tallied February 22, 1977. Elected were: Bruce Bennett, Chairman; Bob Barney, Jack Berryman. Roberta Park and Mike Salter, Board members. Not elected were Steve Riess and Larry Fielding.

Due to late publication of the call for nominations for the bi-annual election, the committee was unable to complete the slate by the November 17 Constitutional deadline. Minimum input from members was obtained for the same reason. A list of 25 nominees for the 6 offices was submitted to the Secretary-Treasurer on February 3, 1977. Due to the short time remaining, he was requested to ascertain their willingness to run, obtain their vita, and publish the ballot as expeditiously as possible.

No further information was available at the time this report was due. The committee recommends that should the members wish to continue holding elections by mail, the following changes be implemented: (1) Amend the constitution to provide the nominating committee sufficient time to complete its task. (2) Ensure adequate input from members regarding nominations. (3) Obtain a list of willing candidates from which the final slate may be drawn.
