## Avery Brundage Collection

Just published is a bibliography of the Avery Brundage collection which is housed at the University of Illinois Archives. Brundage was a 1912 participant in the Olympic decathlon along with Jim Thorpe and George S. Patton. In 1929 he became president of the U.S. Olympic Committee continuing until 1952 when he was elected president of the International Olympic Committee. In addition, he was a seven term president of the AAU and a founder and president of the Pan-American games. His files located at the University of Illinois are invaluable to the study of American and international sport.
