## R. Tait McKenzie Symposium on Sport

An R. Tait McKenzie Symposium on Sport is being sponsored by the Department of Physical Education at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, May 5-6, 1978. The McKenzie Symposium, in honor of the noted sculptor, medical doctor, and physical educator of the early decades of the 20th century, is being devoted to the humanistic understanding of sport. The symposium will use the broad base of humanities -linguistics, religious studies, jurisprudence, history, philosophy, and the fine arts-as well as the social sciences to look at the phenomonon of sport. The University of Tennessee, Knoxville, is the site of the R. Tait McKenzie Museum which houses the extensive Joseph B. Wolffe collection of McKenzie works.
