

DISTINGUISHED LECTURES COMMITTEE REPORT

The Distinguished Lectures Committee named Eliot Asinof to deliver the Betts Address and Robert Barney to give the Howell Address. No effort was made to have the Staley Address presented this year.

Selection of the speakers was accomplished at a meeting of the committee during the 1977 convention. At that time potential speakers were ranked and the Chairman directed to seek the acceptance of invitations to speak according to preferences established by the committee.

It was also the decision of the committee to permit the Chairman to seek only two speakers. This departure from established practice was viewed as a desirable experiment; one that would give NASSH members an opportunity to assess a program with only two highlight events rather than the usual three. The committee plans to continue the experiment next year by offering the Staley Address and either the Betts or Howell.
