

# Distinguished Lectures Committee Report

The Distinguished Lectures Committee named Dr. Roberta Park of the University of California/Berkeley to deliver the Staley Address and Dr. Michael Salter to give the Howell Address. Following the directive of the Council that only two principal speeches be given at the convention, no effort was made to have the Betts Address as a part of the 1979 meeting.

Selection of speakers was accomplished through a mail ballot, following an earlier solicitation of recommendations. The ballot made clear the preferences of committee members making it possible for the Chairman to seek acceptances from those persons enjoying the highest ratings.

The Guidelines to be used in taking care of the expenses of speakers are as follows:

1. Members of NASSH cannot receive payment from the treasury for services rendered or to cover expenses.
2. Up to \$500 per year shall be available to Distinguished Lectures Committee for use as honoraria or to reimburse expenses.
