STATEMENT REGARDING THE FINANCIAL SITUATION

With the increase of institutional membership and no loss of individual membership, the North American Society for Sport History showed a slight increase in cash reserves in 1979 over 1978. However, if three issues of the JOURNAL OF SPORT HISTORY would have been paid for in 1979, instead of two, there would have been a slight loss. The financial stability of NASSH in 1979 will probably not necessitate an increase in membership dues until 1982.
