# Constitution and By-Laws Report

President Remley referred one problem to the Constitution and By-Law Committee regarding the election of the Chairperson of the Publications Board.

This problem was discussed by the Committee, resulting in the following: Please refer to Article VI, Publications; Sections 1 through 4 appear to be appropriate. Section 5 must be changed to include some statement identifying how and when the Chair is elected. We recommend Section 5 to read:

*Recommendation:*

*Section 5* – The Board shall consist of five members, one of whom shall be elected Chair by the constituent members at the time of the annual meeting of NASSH for a period of two years. Members shall be elected to three year terms except at the first election, one member shall be elected to a two year term and one member to a one year term. Board members are prevented from serving as Editor of the NASSH publications.
