

Distinguished Lecture Committee Report

Following the suggestion first made by the 1978 committee of offering two, rather than three Distinguished Lectures, the Committee selected the following persons for the Lectures:

John R. Betts Address - Donald Mrozek, Kansas State

Seward Staley Address - Marvin Eyler, University of Maryland and Nancy Struna, University of Minnesota

The choice of two persons for the Staley Address is an unusual departure from the past; however, it is not to be construed as precedent setting. Because 1982 is the tenth anniversary conference of NASSH, the Committee hoped to offer something unique in the Staley Lecture. Two persons, representing the earliest beginnings of NASSH as well as its later development were selected and asked to present the Lecture in the form of a dialogue rather than the usual individual presentation. We hope the NASSH membership will feel that the tenth anniversary will be appropriately celebrated in this way.
