STATEMENT REGARDING THE FINANCIAL SITUATION

NASSH's financial picture remains solid as does its membership. There has been a steady increase in institutional membership since the origin of the Society, while individual membership has grown moderately over the past several years. The financial reserve of over \$25,000 will allow the Society to carry out special projects if it chooses to do so. The cost of publishing the Journal of Sport History and the Proceedings has remained stable, and there appears to be no need to raise membership dues in the near future.
