PURPOSE AND ORGANIZATION

The International Centre for Olympic Studies is a research, resource, and service facility located in Somerville House, The University of Western Ontario, London, Canada. The Centre's purpose is to encourage, generate, and disseminate scholarship on a broad range of social and cultural themes related to the Modern Olympic Movement.

It seeks to do this through several initiatives. First, the Centre publishes an annual scholarly journal called *OLYMPIKA: The International Journal of Olympic Studies*. Second, in every Olympic year (biennially) the Centre organizes and stages an international symposium for Olympic research. the *PROCEEDINGS* of which are published at the time of the symposium. Third. the Centre sponsors guest lectures on Olympic themes, the most important of which are the annual Crocker, Zeigler and Ioannides Lectures. Fourth, in its Somerville House Research Facility (Room 2331). the Centre maintains resources and facilities for the use of visiting scholars worldwide, as well as for faculty members. graduate and undergraduate students at The University of Western Ontario.
