Call for Abstracts

7th International Symposium for Olympic Research Thursday, October 21 - Saturday, October 23, 2004 The University of Western Ontario London, Canada

The International Centre for Olympic Studies at The University of Western Ontario in London, Canada is pleased to announce the 7th International Symposium for Olympic Research. The Symposium will be held at the Windermere Manor located on campus Thursday 21 October - Saturday 23 October 2004. The program committee welcomes detailed abstracts 750-1000 words in length to be submitted by 15 March 2004, information below. The program will be limited to 21 papers in non-competing sessions. Abstracts will be adjudicated in a process of peer review according to the clarity of the research question and main thesis, the substantive and/or theoretical contributions to the sub-disciplinary or interdisciplinary literature in any of the fields of history, sociology, philosophy, and anthropology, and the breadth of primary and secondary sources. The full papers will be edited and pre-published for symposium participants and are due 16 July 2004. Graduate student submissions are welcome.
