



7 KASEY KELLER. Commanded the box well. Stretched low to deflect a low drive and flew high to tip away a header. Held his ground to stop PK. Off his line a bit on the goal.

4 FRANKIE HEJDUK. Crossing was weak. Didn't support midfielders in the first half. Ran and ran and pushed the ball forward a lot in the second half.

5 JEFF AGOOS. Had to put out a few fires but also sparked one or two. Good tackle stopped Choi Yong Soo late in the match. Thumped the ball rather than passed it.

4 DAN CALIFF. Started horribly by giving away penalty and endured miserable first half. Improved greatly and stopped Choi with a tough tackle. Might have been punished for reckless tackle on Park Ji Sung in final minutes but play was offside.

4 CARLOS BOCANEGRA. Reacted slowly to situations. Was strong in the tackle but didn't make many of them.

7 LANDON DONOVAN. Faded for periods of the match yet dazzled with some superb touches. Did a better job of matching opponents physically than in December meeting.

5 CHRIS ARMAS. Stranded in the first half as balls and Korean opponents flew at him.

2 EDDIE LEWIS. Didn't help defensively. Attacking runs and crosses were infrequent and inept.

3 MANNY LAGOS. Struggled from start to finish. Did a little defensive work in the second half but seldom contributed to the attack.

5 BRIAN MCBRIDE. Quiet for long stretches but did test the keeper. Defused a dangerous situation with a cool clearance and put ball through for Donovan to force red-card tackle.

5 ANTE RAZOV. Set up first goal with sublime chip. Checked back to find the ball and passed fairly well. At times abandoned the box unwisely.
