● **Jovan Kirovski** scored for the second time in three English Premier League starts for Birmingham City in a 1-1 tie with Everton on Boxing Day. Kirovski, only the third American to score in the Premier League after John Harkes (Sheffield Wednesday) and Joe-Max Moore (Everton), started the next three games for Birmingham, all losses.

● **Jonny Walker's** bid for the Chilean double was thwarted when Universidad Catolica lost to Santiago rival Colo Colo, 2-0 and 3-2, in the final of the Torneo Clausura. UC had defensive general Miguel Ramirez red-carded in the first leg and two other players ejected in the second leg.
