Farragut's victory was gained by a single target, 204 to 203. The champions won four of the six shots and the other two went to Farragut. West Collingswood trailed in all the matches, but showed better form with each shoot, and in yesterday's match had both the other clubs worried from the jump. When the last squad went to the traps yesterday it looked as though Riverton was due for its fifth victory. It was up to Chambers, who made 22 on his first trip, to bring another victory to his team.
