### MINNESOTA STATE TOURNEY

Fred Richter Captures Interstate Association's Amateur Championship.

Minneapolis, Minn., June 30.—The Minnesota State championship tournament was decided over the traps of the Minneapolis Rod and Gun Club, on June 19 and 20. Weather was perfect the first day, but marred by rain on the second day. Fred Richter, of Minneapolis, was the winner of the Minnesota State amateur championship, breaking 98 targets out of a possible 100. Richter was going in rare form, breaking 68 targets without a miss. W. H. Rickart was the winner of second honors, with a mark of 96. High amateur for the two days was W. S. Hoon, of Jewell, Ia., who broke 288 out of 300 regular targets. The professional honors fell to Homer Clark, of Alton, Ills., with 332 out of 350. The special event was won by Frank Novotny, of St. Paul, with 47 out of 26 singles and 12 pairs.
