HONORS FOR CROTHERS SECOND DAY

To E. K. Crothers, of Bloomington, went the honors on the second day. He not only took the amateur honors with 140 out of 150, leading the best professional by six targets,

but also took second place in the L. C. Smith two-shot championship. The latter event was won by J. Rollins, also of Bloomington, who tied with Crothers at 49 out of 50, and captured the honor with 21 straight in a missed-and-out shoot-off. Second place in the 150-target race went to a tie between Robison and Eagle, who each broke 138. Jay E. Graham topped the professional list with 134, William R. Crosby finishing second with 132, and Fred G. Bills third with 131. In the two-shot race, Graham again led the professionals with 49. The scores:
