The Coming Events



ON THE threshold of a new trap shooting year the various gun clubs about the country are busily engaged in arranging club and league shoots and getting in shape for the holding of registered tournaments. As regards the registered tournaments, those gun clubs which desire to hold these events will do well to get into touch at once with Secretary E. Reed Shaner, of the Interstate Association, and obtain information as to the method to be followed this year in asking for registered tournaments. In past years the tournaments have been registered under the new policy with the Interstate added money donation so long as the funds provided for that purpose held out. After that all gun clubs that desired registration were forced to enter their clubs under the old policy, obtaining the benefit of the Interstate sanction and the recording of the averages and publication of the scores officially in "Sporting Life," but did not receive any money donations. In the past many desirable clubs have been overlooked in this owing to this method of doing business. Now, under the new method, no tournament will be registered until after February 15. All applications must be in before that time, and when the time limit on requests has expired in the middle of February, then the Interstate officials in Pittsburgh will have the task of arranging the entire season's registration. Within a reasonable date after the middle of February an announcement will be made of the list eligible to hold these events, and they will be so distributed throughout the country that all will have a chance at them. As usual, this year "Sporting Life" will publish all of the registered tournaments, being the only publication having access to the official registered tournament scores. Along with this the registered official averages will be published once every month. As there are no registered tournaments scheduled as yet, the schedule list below contains only the list of unregistered tournaments for the near future. In addition, there will be found appended thereto a list of gun clubs who hold regular periodical shooting contests. This will be added to or changed from time to time at the request of gun club officials. "Sporting Life" earnestly requests gun club officials to keep this list before them and make changes whenever necessary. It will have regular publication during the season when the opportunity and space permit. The schedule and fixtures are as follows:
