

Phil Soar and Martin Tyler, *Encyclopedia of British Football*. William Collins, London, 1933 (3rd updating). Illus., tables, pp.246. \$14.95.

This is a lavish coffee-table volume with a brief and season-by-season overview of the history of British soccer and its major competitions. However, it will be of more value as a reference item. It has extensive sections on all the major clubs, with basic information about each club and its year-by-year record, and it includes season-by-season tables of results (for all divisions) from the inception of competition to 1982-83. This handsome and reasonably-priced book is well worth a place in the researcher's library.
