Manuscripts submitted for publication should be typed and should follow the conventions of Australian style as set out in the *Style Manual for Authors, Editors and Printers* published by the Australian Government Publishing Service (4th edition). All articles are refereed and should not normally exceed 6000 words in length. Footnotes and references should be grouped at the end of the article. Contributors are encouraged to submit manuscripts on disk. We prefer MF2-DD Apple Format, Word 5, but other systems can be handled.

Articles should deal with the economic, political, social, legal or philosophical significance of sporting activity. While most articles in the past have been on Australian sport and have had an historical focus, articles on other societies and on contemporary sport may be submitted for consideration.

Subscriptions to the Australian Society of Sports History are due on 1 July each year. Payment, in Australian dollars, or by Visa Card, Bankcard or Mastercard should be made out to the Australian Society for Sports History and sent to the Treasurer, Imke Fischer, Department of HMS, Australian Catholic University, PO Box 968, North Sydney, NSW 2059.
